

Questions for Caregiver Discussion

Print out and cut the questions into strips. Place the strips in a bowl or face down on the table for caregivers to take. Have caregivers volunteer to read their question and start the discussion.

What landmarks or significant signs are near your home and does your child know them?

Has your child memorized your phone number, their address, their birthdate, your name, and their full name? If yes, how did you help them learn these things?

Are there any neighborhood activities that you and your child participate in?

When is it okay for your child to speak to a stranger? Do you think your child would speak to a stranger when necessary?

When is it not okay to speak to a stranger? How can you help your child understand the difference between when it is okay to speak to a stranger and when it is not okay to speak to a stranger?
